Maximum one (1) team per NOC in the Mixed Team competition composed of two (2) male and two (2) female athletes, maximum one (1) team per NOC in the Mixed Doubles competition composed of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

An NOC may have one (1) team in each event giving a maximum of two (2) teams.

B.3. TYPE OF ALLOCATION OF QUOTA PLACES:

The quota place is allocated to the NOC by event.

C. Athlete Eligibility

All athletes participating in the YOG must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force. Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, as well as with the rules of the World Curling Federation (WCF), may participate in the YOG.

C.1. AGE REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible to participate in the Winter Youth Olympic Games Gangwon 2024, athletes must have been born between 1 January 2006 and 31 December 2009.

C.2. ADDITIONAL IF REQUIREMENTS:

An NOC is only eligible to qualify for the Winter Youth Olympic Games Gangwon 2024 if they enter at least one team into the World Junior Curling Championships (WJCC) OR World Junior B Curling Championships (WJBCC) during the qualification period OR has participated in the 2022 World Curling Academy Youth Training Programme.

National Federation Representing Great Britain

The three National Federations from Great Britain - England, Scotland and Wales - are all eligible to participate in World Curling Championships. However, by an agreement between the Curling Federations of Scotland, England and Wales, only Scotland will be allocated qualifying points for Great Britain.

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The Host Country is entitled to one (1) team for the Mixed Team competition composed of two (2) male and two (2) female athletes, and one (1) team for the Mixed Doubles competition composed of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

E. Confirmation Process for Quota Places

Following each qualification event, the WCF will publish the results on its website (www.worldcurling.org).

WCF will publish the YOG ranking list referred to in **D.1.1** immediately following the conclusion of the WJCC 2023 and inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places within two (2) days after the publication of the YOG Ranking List. The NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph **G. Qualification Timeline**.

F. Reallocation of Unused Quota Places

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES

If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated in accordance with the following order:

- F.1 If the quota place was earned through **D.1.2** or **D.2.2**, the quota place will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified of the same qualifying zone based on the YOG Ranking List.
- F.1.1 In the case of **D.2.2 (c)**, if the quota place is still available after **F.1**, it will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC from Asia.
- F.2 If the quota place in **F.1** and **F.1.1** is still available, the quota place will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified on the YOG Ranking List regardless of qualifying zone.
- F.3 If the quota place was earned through **D.1.3** or **D.2.3**, the quota place will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified on YOG Ranking List regardless of qualifying zone.
- F.4 If the quota place was earned through **D.1.4** or **D.2.4**, the quota place will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified on YOG Ranking List regardless of qualifying zone.
- F.5 If there are still available quota places, the WCF will allocate the quota to the next best ranked NOC whose team participated in the 2022 World Curling Academy Youth Training Programme competition.
- F.6 In the event of cancellation of the World Junior Curling Championships (WJCC) and World Junior B Curling Championships (WJBCC) during the competition season of 2022/23, unused quota places for the Mixed Team and Mixed Doubles will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC based on the accumulated points in the Junior Men's and Junior Women's World Ranking as of **31 December 2023**.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACE

The unused Host Country Place will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified from the Asian qualifying zone on the YOG Ranking List.

If the case where the list of Asian NOCs on the YOG Ranking List has been exhausted, the Host Country Place will be reallocated to the next best-ranked NOC not yet qualified on the YOG Ranking List regardless of qualifying zone.

In the event of cancellation of the World Junior Curling Championships (WJCC) and World Junior B Curling Championships (WJBCC) during the competition season of 2022/23, the unused Host Country Place will be reallocated according to **F.6**.
